Dear Airport Tenants and Stakeholders:

In the previous document sent on September 7, 2015 titled "Restriction of Access Points", we advised the restriction of access points here at MSP Int'l Airport. Though we have made great strides since September towards the goal to have one "Public to Sterile" access point at each terminal, the access reduction process is not complete.

A new employee portal is scheduled to be completed by approximately July 6, 2016. Access to doors LT-2ST30B, LT-2273A, LT-1ST04, and LT-1061B will be closed for general use on (approximately) July 13th, 2016. Because the access to the sterile area will be limited to that one employee entrance, you will see an increase of inspections at that location. You may need to allow yourself an additional 1-3 minutes to get to your workspace due to inspections.

Employees that currently are screened at TSA checkpoints will continue to be screened at the checkpoints. The employee portal door will be used for work purposes only by those employees that currently use various terminal doors to access the Sterile Area. This direct "Public to Sterile" employee portal door will be located on the Terminal 1 Ticketing Level across from Door 4 in the former Checkpoint 4 area. This access point does not require stairs for access. The door will also feature an auto-opener function to hold the door open for carts, dollies, and other large items. Once this door is operational, we will continue access reduction at other public doors leading into the Sterile and SIDA areas. Temporary signs will be posted at each door to assist employees by directing them to the new employee portal.

Lastly, MSP will be going through changes and renovations in the ticketing and baggage areas over the next couple of years. There may be changes to the employee portal during that time. We will keep you posted as to those changes and will work closely with MAC Development and others to minimize the impact on your transit to work.
