### **JOB SUMMARY**

Airport Fire Fighters respond to emergency and non-emergency incidents which may include medical, fire suppression, and rescue services. These services may be on-airport, off-airport and include mutual aid. In addition, Airport Fire Fighters may also participate in public education programs.

### **MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS**

- High school diploma or equivalent.
- Minimum of two years fire fighter work experience (full-time, part-time, paid on-call, volunteer, or military).
- Valid government issued driver's license that is unrestricted except for corrective lenses.
- MN Board of Fire Fighter Training and Education (MBFTE) MN Fire Fighter License or ability to obtain within one year of employment.
- Completion of a 40 hour HAZMAT Operations course or equivalent or NFPA 472 Operations Level Certification.
- Current Minnesota Fire Service Certification Board (MFSCB) Fire Fighter II certification or International Fire Service Accreditation Congress (IFSAC) Fire Fighter II certification.
- Current Minnesota Emergency Medical Services Regulation Board (EMSRB) or National Registry Emergency Medical Technician (EMT) certification.
- Ability to report for duty within one hour of notification for emergencies and overtime situations.
- Clear articulate English for radio communication.
- Operating telephone service.

### **DESIRABLE REQUIREMENTS**

- Associates Degree in Fire Protection or Fire Science.
- Completion of Fire Protection or Fire Science Technical Certificate (40-60 Credits).
- Completion of two or more years post secondary education.
- Completion of 40 hours Aircraft Rescue and Fire Fighting (ARFF) Training program.
- Two or more years of ARFF work experience.
