'Test-to-treat' COVID-19 site opens at MSP

People who test positive for COVID-19 at the MSP Airport testing site can now be evaluated onsite by a medical professional and get a prescription for the antiviral drug if deemed appropriate.

Only patients deemed high risk by a clinician will receive a prescription for <u>Paxlovid</u>, which has received emergency approval from the FDA to treat COVID-19.

The "test-to-treat" site is on Level 2 of the Blue Ramp at Terminal 1 and is open from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m. The services are free to Minnesotans.

Walk-ins are accepted but appointments are recommended at mn.gov/covid19.

Employee Portal Move

The employee portal in Departures will soon be closing.

All employees will begin using SOUTH CHECK POINT starting Tuesday, October 4th.

Employees entering through the Checkpoint will be subject to TSA rules. 3.4 oz. is the limit- no oversized liquids. This is a big change from the current rules at the Employee Portal.

Escorting is also no longer available- guests will need concourse guest passes.

The current escort procedure used in the center portal will no longer be available. Concourse passes (or gate passes for airline guests) will now be required for all guest access to the secure side of the terminal. If the unbadged individual needs access beyond passenger areas of the terminals, a badge holder with an "E" escort symbol on their badge may escort the individual by following MSP security procedures.

Only pre-authorized representatives from each company have the authority to request a concourse pass. Authorized representatives can email concourse-pass@mspmac.org and include each visitor's full legal name, date of birth and gender. Also include the day and approximate time that the guest will pick up the concourse pass at the tram level information desk at Terminal 1. Your guest will need a government-issued ID to receive the concourse pass from staff at the information desk.

A 24-hour notice is appreciated for a concourse pass, though last-minute requests can be facilitated. In that instance, guests may encounter a short wait at the information desk.



- 1. At precisely 7:46am an announcement will go out over the PA system (campus wide) recognizing the anniversary of the 9/11 attacks.
 - > 7:46am TSA pauses operations within security checkpoints during program.
 - > 7:46am EVIDS in security checkpoints switch over to American flag waving.
 - 7:46am Honor guard (APD, Fire, CBP) presence at T1 (Ticketing mezzanine abeam of United ticket counters), and at T2 (adjacent to security checkpoint 1).
- 2. Approximately 7:46:30 Taps plays.
- 3. Approximately 7:48am Announcement goes out to thank you for your cooperation after Taps. Program concludes.
- 4. All MSP Stakeholders please pause operations during this time and turn down music in all leased spaces.

- GOAL: Improve accessibility to information airline gate agents provide by converting their announcements to text and displaying that on gate monitors as close to real-time as possible
- TIMING: Will be functioning in MAC IT lab no later than September 21 (date of ACI Accessibility tour)
- TEST LOCATIONS: Once proven in lab then E1-E4, H12
