DRIVER'S LICENSE REQUEST FORM
Supplemental Instructions

Under Section 2, select **only one** of the following license types:

License categories issued to cars, trucks, vans, etc (all vehicles with the exception of tugs):

- Runway License** – authorizes the driver to operate a vehicle on all runways, taxiways, and safety areas at MSP.
- Taxiway License** – authorizes the driver to operate a vehicle on all taxiways and taxiway safety areas at MSP.
- Limited Taxiway – Military** – authorizes the driver to operate a vehicle on all taxiways north of Runway 12L/30R.
- Ramp/Road** – authorizes the driver to operate a vehicle only on the non-movement areas (ramps and roads) at MSP.
- MAC** – MAC use only. Authorizes the driver to operate a MAC vehicle. This license category only applies when the driver is not applying for any of the other license categories listed above.

License categories issued to tugs:

- Tow License** – authorizes the driver to tow aircraft on all taxiways and runways.
- Limited Tow - Lindbergh License** – authorizes the driver to tow aircraft on all taxiways between runways 12L/30R and 12R/30L, as well as the portion of runway 4/22 between runways 12L/30R and 12R/30L.
- Limited Tow – Humphrey License** – authorizes the driver to tow aircraft only on runways 4/22 and 17/35 and on all taxiways south of runway 12R/30L.
- Limited Tow - Military License** – authorizes the driver to tow aircraft only on taxiways north of runway 12L/30R and on runway 4/22 north of runway 12L/30R.
- Limited Tow – Infield Cargo License** – authorizes the driver to tow aircraft only on taxiway T between taxiways M and Y.
- Pushback License** – authorizes the driver to pushback aircraft (and return to the same gate only) anywhere on the airport. This license also authorizes the driver to conduct off-gate deicing.

Note: All Tow and Limited Tow licenses also include authorization to push back aircraft anywhere on the airport.
