When we got to the airport we were able to get Willard into the wheelchair we brought and up on the sidewalk, when a police officer asked us if we wanted assistance. It was Officer Zizzo. We gladly accepted help and he summoned Officer McDonald help as well. They took Willard into the airport, got someone there with a wheelchair to transfer him from ours, and basically took care of everything. It felt as if they were our guardian angels, making this "transaction" as smooth as it could possibly be (an old woman and a middle aged woman helping an 87 year old immobile man into the airport!)
