Snedker had taken Juuno to his squad car to warm him up and then returned to help Buth. Snedker fell through at one point to his helps. Snedker and I both later marveled that Buth was able to stay dry. I am not one to take chances, but I had no choice but to save my dog. He's the best dog and I love him. I am sincerely grateful for the help from both of your officers, the risks they took, and the special compassion that Adam Snedker showed Juuno, and me.
